This Addendum is issued to document clarifications and modifications to the Contract Documents for the Boquet River Non-Point Source Pollution Improvement Project. This Addendum is made a part of the Contract Documents. Each bidder must acknowledge receipt of the Addendum on the Proposal Form.

- 1. A discrepancy has been found between the details regarding the engineered log jams (ELJs) and specification 212.0 regarding the size of logs required. The specification shall rule in this matter. Therefore, the logs referenced in the details as 18" TO 30" Ø LOGS shall be approximately 24" diameter at breast height (DBH) or larger and the logs referenced in the details as 10" TO 18" Ø LOGS shall be 10" to 18" DBH or larger.
- 2. Question from prospective bidder: Can the stumps that have to be removed from prior cutting be disposed on site or must they be removed from the site? Response: The stumps must be removed from the site.
- 3. Question from prospective bidder: Do you have a detail for the two permanent project signs as well as the one temporary one? If not, is there an allowance we should carry?

 Response: Bidders should carry an allowance of \$1,500.00 for temporary and permanent signs. Pages 8-10 of the Bid Proposal has been revised to reflect the allowance. Use the REVISED BID PROPOSAL attached to this Addendum for submitting your bid.
