1. Wherever in the Contract Plans or Proposal the old item listed below appears, the new item shall apply.

- 2. The following clarifications are being distributed to all bidders as a result of questions from individual plan holders:
  - a. The paving limits described in Bid Alternate 1 will be a continuous 1.5 miles as determined by the Engineer and the County.
  - b. The limits of the pavement repair areas as shown on sheet MSD-7 are located at the following locations on the horizontal control line. It shall be noted that this horizontal control line outside of the Forest Preserve was based on aerial imagery and is approximate only.

## **DESCRIPTION**

This work consists of furnishing, placing and compacting a subbase course in conformity with the lines, grades, thicknesses and typical sections shown on the plans, or as determined by field conditions and ordered in writing by the Engineer. All provisions of Section 304 *Subbase Course* for Type 2 subbase shall apply except as modified by this specification.

SUBBASE COURSE, ADIRONDACK OPTIONAL shall consist of a single layer of material of either Type 2 OR Adirondack Type as described in this specification.

### **MATERIALS**

Provide materials meeting the requirements of EITHER:

- 1. Type 2 subbase, OR;
- 2. Adirondack Type. All material requirements for Type 2 apply, except that this material shall consist of crushed boulders/cobbles. Crushed Boulders/Cobbles shall be Material Designation 703-0405 and shall be a product of a crushing operation, and shall consist of clean, durable, sharp-angled fragments of Boulders/Cobbles free from coatings. A crushed particle shall be defined as one in which the total area of face fracture exceeds 75% of the maximum cross-sectional area of the particle, as measured under ASTM D 5821.
