SUBJECT: Addendum #4 MODULAR KITCHEN

This Addendum, issued to bid document holders of record, indicates changes to the bid documents for the *MODULAR KITCHEN* Bid Opening August 19, 2016.

Please note the following QUESTIONS & ANSWERS regarding the Pre-Bid Meeting:

Questions are answered in RED

- Will the Modular kitchen require sprinkling? No
- Confirm the modules be placed at grade? Yes

• The 4-module kitchen will be placed on a foundation, the coolers will be placed on concrete slabs? Confirm or advise. That is correct

- Wood Frame Modular Construction? Yes
- Confirm option to deliver two 8x20 freezers will be delivered in advance of modular complex delivery and installation. Yes
- Exterior will be Hardy Panel or similar equivalent Yes

• Grease Trap will be required? Installed onsite by county? Yes a grease trap will be required and will be installed by the County onsite.

• Confirm crawl space with exterior access to plumbing underneath; by county (no need for access from within the modules? Yes there will be a crawl space under the facility, access will be from the exterior and not through the modular complex.

Is access to roof from within the complex required? No

• Essex to have floor plan updated with additional detail - Essex County is unable to provide a more detailed floor plan at this time.

Industry Typical Recommendations:

- Tempered Make Up air for Hood over equipment Yes Provide tempered air make-up for the hood unit in bid price.
- Selected bidder to provide complete stamped drawing set (cost included in bid) Yes

Equipment:

- Do the 25 food carriers need to carry full sheet pans? If so, how many and how deep? No. Comparable to Nutri-System Corp NS2-E 2-compartment meal transporters.
- What is the capacity of the ice bin? 400 lb

Additional Questions are answered in RED

1.) Preferences for interior and exterior finishes.(mainly flooring, interior and exterior wall finish) Exterior finish to be a cement board siding such as a Hardy plank. Interior finishes to be FRP wall panels and a heavy duty vinyl flooring (roll goods with with welded seams)

2.) Type of foundation you will construct. - Essex County will construct a concrete foundation with frost walls and interior concrete piers so that the modular units will stay at finish grade with a crawl space beneath the modular units for plumbing and other utilities.

- 3.) What the desired finished floor hgt will be. Even with finish grade
- 4.) Confirmation that 5B construction is acceptable. Wood frame construction is acceptable
- 5.) That clear span construction is not required. Essex County will accept a few support columns
- 6.) Project start and completion date. Award Bid in late summer/ early fall 2016, installation in Summer of 2017
- 7.) Do you want wall mounted or roof mounted HVAC units. Roof Mounted is acceptable
- 8.) "Basis of Design" or "Or Equal" for all kitchen equipment. Or Equal
- 9.) Is a typical 1/4" per 1' crowned EPDM roof acceptable. Yes
