

Services for Persons with Disabilities

Essex County buses are fully accessible to persons with disabilities. If you have questions or concerns please contact our One Call Center for more information.

Flag Down Service

Flag down service is available along all routes. Flag the bus by waving, the bus driver will stop at the closest safe location to pick riders up. If you are within ¹/₄ mile from a bus stop please walk to the bus stop.

Non-Scheduled Stops

You may notify the driver that you wish to depart the bus at a different location from the scheduled stop.

Route Deviation

Route deviations of up to ³/₄ mile are available upon request for an additional \$1.00 to the regular fare. Route deviations must be scheduled with the One Call Center at least 24 hours prior to the travel.

Veterans Medical Transportation

Veterans needing transportation to medical appointments on regular routes may travel for free.
