**JOB SUMMARY-COMPUTER PROGRAMMER/ANALYST:** The work involves learning and the use of the computer programming language to create and maintain computer software programs. The incumbent assists the Sr. Computer Programmer/Analyst by performing a variety of duties related to the operation of the Information Systems Department. The work is performed under the direct supervision of the Sr. Computer Programmer/Systems Analyst. The incumbent does related work as required.

IOB SUMMARY-SENIOR COMPUTER PROGRAMMER/ANALYST: These duties involve responsibility for assisting the Director, Information Systems in developing and implementing small to moderate sized software systems supporting the needs of the Essex County Government Center. The Senior Computer Programmer/Analyst is also responsible for writing programs and supervising the work of subordinate Computer Programmers. The work is performed under the direct supervision of the Director, Information Systems in accordance with established policies and procedures. The incumbent does related work as required.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: SENIOR COMPUTER PROGRAMMER/ANALYST-Either:

- (a) Possession of a Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science or related field, included or supplemented by sixteen (16) semester hours in computer programming and two (2) years paid experience in the operation and programming of electronic computer systems, which shall have involved systems analysis and computer programming; or
- (b) Possession of an Associate's Degree in Applied Science in Electronic Data Processing and four (4) years paid experience in the operation and programming of electronic computer systems, two years of which shall have involved systems analysis and computer programming; or
- (c) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma, supplemented by six (6) semester hours in computer science (including programming) from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university and five (5) years of paid experience in the operation of electronic computer equipment, two (2) years of which shall have involved systems analysis and computer programming; or
- (d) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a), (b), and (c).

Note: Your degree must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency. A list of acceptable companies who provide this service can be found on the Internet at http://www.cs.ny.gov/jobseeker/degrees.cfm. You must pay the required evaluation fee.

Qualified candidates will be subject to a Civil Service examination to be **Additional Information:** announcement at a later date. Applications will be accepted until the closing date for the examination. Persons seeking employment with Essex County shall be required to submit to a drug and alcohol screening/testing, preemployment physical, and additionally may be required to submit to a fingerprint background check, depending upon the specific requirements of the position.

\*The term provisional means that you will be required to take the next civil service examination for this title and place among the top three (3) candidates on the examination list in order to be eligible for permanent appointment.
