DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This is an administrative and professional position in the Office of Emergency Services. Responsibilities include planning, organizing, and developing plans for Hazardous Materials and Weapons of Mass Destruction response activities. In addition the incumbent is responsible for training of the Hazardous Materials/WMD Emergency Response Team. The work is performed under the supervision of the Director and/or Deputy Director of Emergency Services. The incumbent does related work as required.
