IN THE TOWN OF LEWIS, N. Y.

- NO I ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Thompson Bridge across Spruce Mill Brook near Lewis Center, 20 feet 3 inches long, 15 feet wide, plank floor, concrete abutments in fair condition.
- " 2 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Cornwright Brige across Spruce Mill Brook, length 16 feet, wedth 15 feet, concrete abutments plank floor, all in good condition.
- " 3 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Derby Bridge across Turner brook, length 12 feet, wedth 13 feet, wood ~~abutments in~~ *Good*..... condition.
- " 4 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Mussey Bridge across Turner Brook Length 14 feet, wedth 14 feet, plank floor, and concrete abutments, in *Good*.....condition.
- " 5 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Greenwood Bridge across Spruce Mill Brook, length 18 feet, wedth 14 feet, plank floor, concrete abutments, in good condition.
- " 6 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the sheep Vat bridge, length 8 feet, wedth 13 feet, plank floor dry stone abutments, log stringers, in *Poor*..... condition.
- " 7 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Chauncy Denton Bridge, across the Foundery Brook, length 13 feet 6 inches, wedth 13 feet, plank floor, log stringers, dry stone wall abutments, in very poor condition.
- " 8 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Hinds Bridge, across the Phelps Brook, length 16 feet, wedth 13 feet, wood stringers, dry stone wall abutments, in very poor condition.
- " 9 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the ' Guss Goff Bridge ' across Phelps Brook, length 14 feet, wedth 14 feet, log stringers, plank floor, dry stone abutments, in poor condition.
- " 10 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Frank Bartlett Bridge, length 13 feet, wedth 14 feet, log stringers, plank floor, dry stone wall abutments, in good condition.
- " 11 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Fred Roberts Bridge, length 13 feet, wedth 14 feet, plank floor, stone mason work abutments in *Good*..... condition.
- " 12 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Kellogg Bridge, plank floor, stone mason abutments, length 14 feet, wedth 14 feet, in good condition.
- " 13 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the wescott Bridge, Length 17 feet wedth 13 feet, wood stringers, log abutments, in poor condition.
- " 14 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Joe Martin Bridge located on the road leading from state road to willsboro, lensth 16 feet, wedth 13 feet, log stringers and plank floor, dry stone abutments in poor condition.
- " 15 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the ..... Bridge, across the Nichols School housebrook, length 11 feet, wedth 13 feet, log stringers, plank floor, dry stone abutments. in ..... condition.
- " 16 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, west of Nichols Schoolhous on x cross road length 15 feet, wedth 13 feet, log stringers, plank floor dry stone wall abutments, in *Poor*..... condition.
- " 17 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, east of Nichols Schoolhous on cross road,

- " 18 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, north of Nichols Schoolhouse, length 13 feet, width 13 feet, plank floor, log stringers and dry stone abutments. in ..... *Poor* ..... condition.
- " 19 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Foundary Bridge, across Foundry Brook, length 11 feet, width 13 feet, plank stringers plank floor, Concrete abutments in good repair.
- ✓ " 20 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Arron Crowningshield Bridge length 37 feet, width 14 feet, cement abutments, plank floor in ..... *Good* ..... condition. ✓
- ✓ " 21 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the John Crowningshield bridge, length 39 feet, width 13 feet, log stringers, plank floor, abutments, ..... *Poor* ..... in poor condition, located in North Lewis. *gone*
- ✓ " 22 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Warren Nichols saw-mill Bridge length 37 feet, width 14 feet, Cement abutments, plank floor, in ..... *Good* ..... condition. X
- " 23 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Alford Spear Bridge, length 13 feet 4 in. width 14 feet, Cement Abutments, plank floor, in good condition.
- ✓ " 24 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Gifford Cross Bridge at deer-head, length 42 feet, width 15 feet, masonlaid stone wall abutments, plank floor, in fair condition X
- ✓ " 25 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the John Crossit Bridge, across North Lewis River, Concrete Abutments, length 36 feet, width 14 feet, plank floor, in good condition. X
- " 26 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Rose Hathaway Bridge, length 16 feet 6 in. width 13 feet, log pears for abutments, log stringers, plank floor, in ..... *Poor* ..... condition.
- " 27 ONE WOODEN BRIDGE, known as the Church Bridge, length 9 feet width 13 feet, log pears for abutments, log stringers, plank floor. in ..... *Poor* ..... condition.
- " 28 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Bever Meadow Bridge, length 13 feet 5 in. width 14 feet 6 in. stone abutments, concrete floor, in good condition.
- " 29 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Carson Bridge across Turner Brook, length 14 feet, width 14 feet, Cement abutments, plank floor, in ..... condition.
- ✓ " 30 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the George Cornwright Bridge, length 29 feet 8 in. width 16 feet, Cement Abutments, plank floor. in good condition. X
- ✓ " 31 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Theodore Tubbs Bridge, length 31 feet, width 14 feet, mason laid wall abutments, plank floor, in ..... *Good* ..... condition. X
- 0 " 32 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Liddy Wardner Bridge, length 29 feet, width 15 feet, Concrete Abutments, Concrete floor, in good condition. X

- ✓ " 34 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the John Dickinson Bridge,  
cross the Lewis River, length 24 feet, width 13 feet, concrete  
abutments, plank floor, in good condition.
- ✓ " 35 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Lewis Saw-mill Bridge,  
length 31 feet, width 16 feet, masonry wall abutments,  
plank floor, in good repair.
- ✓ " 36 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Bishop Bridge, masonry  
laid abutments, length 51 feet, width 14 feet, plank  
floor, in ..... *good* ..... condition.
- ✓ " 37 ONE CONCRETE BRIDGE, known as the Sherman Bridge, across  
spruce mill brook, length 29 feet, width 14 feet, O K.
- ✓ " 38 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Lee Bridge, across the  
Boquet River, This is a town line bridge, 1/2 to be  
maintained by the town of Lewis, whole length of bridge  
100 feet, width 12 feet, stone abutments laid in mortar,  
plank floor, in ..... *good* ..... condition.
- " 39 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the silas Allen Bridge, on  
the road leading from Lewis to Wadhams, length 14 feet  
width 14 feet, stone abutment laid in mortar, plank floor  
in good condition.
- ✓ " 40 ONE IRON BRIDGE, known as the Dave Robb Bridge, across  
the Boquet River, length 91 feet width 14 feet, stone  
abutments laid in mortar, plank floor, in .....  
..... *good* ..... condition.
