JOB SUMMARY: This is a highly technical position involved in the design, development, maintenance, repair, and operation of complex local and wide area computer networks. This class differs from the lower level by the level of independence exercised in the performance of work assignments and the complexity of those assignments. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Network Operations Supervisor with considerable leeway given for the exercise of independent judgment in carrying out the details of the work. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate employees engaged in computer or network operations. The incumbent does related work as required.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A) Possession of a Bachelor's Degree in computer science or related field and one year of supervisory experience in the operation of a computer network; OR
- B) Completion of 60 semester credit hours at a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university, including 12 credits in computer science or electronic data processing, six of which were directly related to the operation of a computer network, and three years experience in the operation of a computer network, one of which must have been in a supervisory capacity; OR
- C) Five years of experience in the operation of a computer network, One year of which must have been in a supervisory capacity; OR
- D) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of A), B) and C) above.
