ACTIVITIES LEADER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES</u> OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for activities within a summer camp program. An activity leader must be competent in activities being conducted. The work is performed under general supervision of a higher level summer camp position. Limited supervision of subordinate staff may be required. The incumbent does related work as required.

<u>TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES</u>: (Illustrative only)

Develop a weekly plan for activities; Review and accesses activities plan for effectiveness; Creates a safe environment for activities to take place; May perform light manual tasks as necessary for the particular activity Keeps the assigned area neat and picked up.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of the organization and conduct of several types of sports, games, hobbies or other recreational activities; ability to maintain simple records; ability to understand and follow simple directions; reliability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (a) Completion of two years of a four year high school; or
- (b) An equivalent combination of training and experience.

* SPECIAL REQUIREMENT
