# FISH HATCHERY ATTENDANT

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: The work involves responsibility for performing a variety of routine manual tasks at the County Fish Hatchery. Work is performed under the direct supervision of higher level fish hatchery employees. Supervision over others is not normally a function of this position. The incumbent does related work as required.
