## GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for keeping the town golf course in good playing condition at all times. Work requires the supervision of a small crew engaged in keeping the greens, fairways and related areas in proper condition. The incumbent works under general supervision of the town supervisor and reports to him periodically. The incumbent does related work as required.

## TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Assigns work to subordinate personnel and helps such personnel to maintain greens, fairways, tees, sand traps, bunkers and related areas; Directs and participates in the mixing and application of sprays used for insect and weed control; oversees the application of top dressing, fertilizer, lime and seed for course improvement; helps to operate tractors, mowers and other mechanical equipment used in maintaining a golf course; inspects cutting and mowing of fairways and greens is responsible for the keeping of necessary supplies, materials and equipment; keeps time records of subordinate employees; inspects machinery and motor equipment to determine proper working condition.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the methods, materials, equipment and practices used in the maintenance of a golf course; good knowledge of the preventative and curative measures available for blight control; familiarity with common turf diseases and ordinary chemicals used to control them; ability to oversee the work of a small crew engaged in golf course maintenance; ability to keep simple work records; resourcefulness; initiative; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (a) Two years of experience in the maintenance of a golf course; or
- (b) Four years of experience in the maintenance of large lawn areas; or
- (c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a) and (b).
