GREENSKEEPER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> The work involves responsibility for performing skilled manual work on, and supervising laborers assigned to the maintenance of the golf course. This work involves the responsibility for the efficient performance of duties relating to the maintenance and care of golf course greens and fairways. The work is performed under general supervision and is subject to periodic inspections. Supervision is exercised over laborers as assigned. The incumbent does related work as required.

<u>TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:</u> (Illustrative only)

Sprays greens for eradication of insects and pests;

Treats grass with fungicides and other chemicals to prevent fungus growth;

Supervises and assists in the mowing of greens, fairways and roughs;

Supervises and helps to sod, seed, fertilize and water fairways and greens;

Spikes, whips and composts greens;

Trims trees and shrubs:

Oversees the cleaning and draining of ditches;

Replaces turf and repairs ball marks on greens;

Performs related greenskeeping tasks as assigned.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the methods, materials and equipment used in greenskeeping and grounds maintenance; ability to diagnose and treat common grass diseases; ability to instruct and supervise others in ordinary golf course maintenance activities; sound judgment; initiative; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (a) Four years of experience in grounds maintenance activities; or
- (b) Two years of experience in the maintenance of a golf course; or
- (c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a) and (b).
