RECREATION TRAILS ATTENDANT

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for a variety of routine manual tasks in the care, minor maintenance and repair to recreation trails, used primarily for hiking, bicycling, cross country skiing, or snowmobiling. This is routine maintenance in keeping the trails to acceptable standards. Work is performed under general supervision of a town supervisor. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

- Makes trails by cutting and removing underbrush and growth;
- May repair foot bridges spanning small streams or gullies;
- Operates small motorized groundkeeping equipment;
- Makes minor repairs to equipment as needed;
- Performs routine manual tasks as required.
- Keeps trails free of refuse and debris;
- Prevents damage to property and patrol trails;

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

General knowledge of operation of small motorized equipment; working knowledge of geography of the area; ability to understand and follow oral or written instructions, dependability, physical condition commensurate to the demands of the positions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Preferably some experience in groundkeeping and completion of a standard grade school course, or any equivalent combination of training and experience sufficient to perform the duties.
