SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> The work involves responsibility for directing traffic at an assigned post during hours when pupils are entering and leaving school. This is a responsible position calling for the exercise of considerable vigilance in directing traffic for the protection of children going to and from school. Work is performed independently with only occasional directions from a superior. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Directs traffic at crosswalks near school;

Assists children crossing street;

Slows down traffic in school zone;

Instructs younger children concerning proper place and precautions to be taken when crossing street.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good general intelligence; ability to be firm yet courteous with the public; ability to get along well with children; some knowledge of first aid methods; good powers of observation; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
