SENIOR RECREATION LEADER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for the professional organization and conduct of a specific segment of one or more parts of the recreation program for the community. Supervision is exercised over subordinate staff. The incumbent does related work as required.

<u>TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:</u> (Illustrative only)

Implements the program which has been planned and approved;camping, etc.;Teaches classes in arts and crafts, athletics, team, group, and individual games, fundamentals of play,camping, etc.;Organizes and supervises the gym and playground program, game room progress, and conductstournaments, plays, parent dayfestivals, groups for social recreation and other special events;festivals, groups for social recreation personnel;Handles publicity for a particular activity; meets with and talks to parent groups;festivals, groups for a particular activity; meets with and talks to parent groups;Keeps records of activities supervised and makes periodic reports;festivals, groups to discuss special problems;Attends staff meetings to discuss special problems;festivals, groups for discuss special in athletic contests when needed.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the purpose, the organization and conduct of several types of recreation activities; ability to direct the work of others; ability to stimulate and maintain the interest of program participants; ability to secure the cooperation of others; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

(a) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two seasons of experience in an organized recreation or athletic program; or

- (b) Four Seasons of experience in the conduct of an organized recreation or athletic program.
- (c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a) and (b).

NOTE:	Season means the annual duration of an organized recreation or athletic program (e.g.	summer	playground
program).
