### SKI AREA MAINTENANCE HELPER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for operating and maintaining the town owned ski slope. This seasonal position exists in the Town of Schroon. The work is performed under general direction of the Town Supervisor with limited leeway allowed for exercise of independent judgment in carrying out details of the work. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Monitor and directs patrons in the proper use of the rope tow;  
Starts and stops engine for tow rope and insures proper safety practices are followed during operation;  
Makes repairs to ski area equipment to provide for efficient and effective operation;  
Checks engine oil level and greases pulleys and bearings on ski tow;  
Performs troubleshooting and minor repairs to rope tow.  
Moves and/or clears snow from various areas to maintain optimal conditions and access to lift and ski areas;  
Prepares a variety of records and reports related to the work.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

General knowledge of the tools and equipment used in maintaining ski slopes, including ski tow machinery and rollers; working knowledge of grounds keeping activities; ability to make minor mechanical repairs to ski area equipment; ability to operate a snow blower; willingness to work outdoors in cold weather, manual dexterity; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
