SKI AREA MAINTENANCE MECHANIC

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> The work involves responsibility for operating and maintaining the town owned ski slope. This seasonal position exists in the Town of Newcomb. The work is performed under general direction of the Town Board with wide leeway allowed for exercise of independent judgment in carrying out details of the work. Supervision may be exercised over the work of laborers. The incumbent does related work as required.

<u>TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:</u> (Illustrative only)

Operates snow making and packing equipment to keep approach area and slope in condition to ski;

Inspects and resurfaces ski slope and trails as needed using hand and power equipment;

Starts and stops engine for tow rope and insures proper safety practices are followed during operation;

Makes repairs to ski area equipment to provide for efficient and effective operation;

Checks engine oil level and greases pulleys and bearings on ski tow;

Operates snow plow to maintain parking area;

Inspects and services lift lines using hand and power tools;

Prepares a variety of records and reports related to the work.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of general operating methods of a ski area; working knowledge of the tools and equipment used in maintaining ski slopes, including ski tow machinery and rollers; working knowledge of grounds keeping activities; ability to make minor mechanical repairs to ski area equipment; ability to operate snow making and grooming equipment; ability to operate a snow blower and plow; willingness to work outdoors in cold weather, manual dexterity; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Two years of general mechanical equipment maintenance experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
