SUPERINTENDENT OF BUILDINGS, GROUNDS AND TRANSPORTATION

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: The work involves responsibility for overseeing the efficient and economical cleaning, repair and maintenance of a medium sized school district and supervising the transportation function. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Superintendent of Schools or other administrative officials with considerable leeway provided for the use of independent judgement in carrying out the technical details of the position. Supervision is exercised over the work of subordinate custodial, maintenance and transportation personnel. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Supervises and inspects the maintenance, repair, cleaning and grounds keeping of the buildings and ground Assigns employees to cleaning, maintenance and bus driving tasks, sets work schedules and assigns priorities:

Prepares tentative budget estimates for custodial, maintenance and transportation activities;

Inspects painting, carpentry, plumbing, electrical and other mechanical and construction work performed by subordinates or

by private contractors;

May personally perform the more difficult maintenance chores;

Drafts specifications and plans for repairs and alterations to buildings and equipment;

Oversees the servicing, maintenance and repair of all school district vehicles and assures that vehicles meet established safety standards;

Plans bus routes including feeder routes and works with the Superintendent of Schools in the preparation of schedules for

private contractors;

Prepares list of children eligible for regular and special transportation;

Conducts a training program for school bus drivers, reviews drivers credentials and prepares accident reports;

Initiates and maintains liaison with principals, teachers, parents and students concerning discipline and safety in the school bus program;

Prepares reports and maintains records concerning buildings, grounds and transportation program as directed.

SUPERINTENDENT OF BUILDINGS, GROUNDS AND TRANSPORTATION

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: The work involves responsibility for planning and overseeing the operations and maintenance program for school district buildings and grounds and for overseeing the district's transportation program. The position also involves responsibility for budget preparation and purchasing. The work is performed under the general direction of the Superintendent of Schools with considerable leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgment in planning and carrying out the technical details of the position. Supervision is exercised over the work of all subordinate custodian, maintenance and transportation personnel. The incumbent can perform work as needed to improve the cleanliness and appearance of the school and grounds. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Directs and oversees the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, repair, cleaning and grounds keeping of school district buildings, grounds and vehicles;

Establishes work schedules and schedules staff to assure adequate coverage for regular and special school activities, and assigns priorities;

May personally perform the more difficult maintenance chores;

Assists with cleaning and maintenance activities when necessary;

Prepares staff evaluations on a yearly basis;

Prepares tentative budget estimates for custodial, maintenance and transportation actitivies;

Maintains records and prepares reports concerning maintenance and transportation activities;

develops, schedules and oversees a preventative maintenance program to keep buildings and equipment in safe operating condition;

Inspects painting, carpentry, plumbing, electrical and other mechanical and construction work performed by subordinates or

by private contractors;

Plans and supervises school district security activities;

Directs snow and ice control activities, landscaping work and the maintenance of athletic fields and activities:

Investigates and reports on damage to buildings with recommendations for repair and prevention;

Prepares preliminary plans, specifications and cost estimates of assigned repair and alteration projects;

Prepares maintenance and operation budgets and justifications:

Maintains records of time and material expended, supplies inventory, and projections of workloads;

Works with individual building principals in establishing emergency evacuation procedures for each school room and office;

Monitor fuel oil deliveries;

Maintains and understands the working components associated with a cogeneration plant;

Devises programs aimed at reducing vandalism, theft and arson;

May be required to act as school bus driver on an assigned route as directed;

Checks to insure that buildings are heated, cleaned, locked and unlocked in readiness for all activities;

Advises the Superintendent of Schools on road hazards for decision on school closing during

inclement weather;

Cooperates with school principals and others responsible for planning special school trips;

Directs transportation operations including bus routing and scheduling, the recruiting and training of drivers and maintenance of vehicles;
